Grade
Stage
7. **Compare & contrast** differences & similarities between 2 topics
best done as a table
8. Describe the **morphology of**: gross + microscopic
9. Describe the Fate disease progress (sequelae or prognosis) +
complications i.e. the good outcome & the bad or complications
10. Discuss **the complications of** :
General complications
Local complication(tissue destruction in a specific site
Complications due to spread
Complications due to healing
- 11 Describe the **manifestations of** : types—Gross & microsc—Clinical
picture if present--- complications
- 12 Etiology includes cause of disease + pathogenesis or mechanism
